PUBLIC NOTICE No. 92/2024/25**Sub- Implementation of Document management System at Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai-reg**

Kind attention of stakeholders, Exporters, Customs brokers etc. is invited to Public Notice No. 06/2015 dated 11.06.2015 and Public Notice No. 23/2022 dated 27.06.2022.

2. As per Public Notice No. 06/2015, the Document Management system was implemented at the Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai with effect from 22.06.2015 and M/s Newgen Software Technologies Limited was entrusted with the collecting charges for DMS. All the Custom Brokers/ Trade/ industry/ importers and Exporters were required to attach the EDI copy of the coupon in the Bill of Entry and Shipping Bill document set while handing over the same to the concerned officers of the Department after LEO/ Out of Charge.

3. Reference may also be invited to Public Notice No. 23/2022 dated 27.06.2022. The relevant portion of the above Public Notice is reiterated as under:

"In case the MCD officers (Superintendent/ Appraising Officer) find any docket which has not been submitted or scanned, the issue shall immediately be brought to the notice of DC/AC SIIB, who shall immediately initiate investigation and take action to recover the docket, by taking appropriate action. In case any person is found to be a habitual defaulter in submitting the dockets, ADC/JC SIIB shall take appropriate action, including putting an alert to warn the officers giving LEO."

Non submission of Shipping Bills for Digitalization wherein LEO has been granted

4. It has been observed that all the Shipping Bills wherein LEO has been granted are not being sent for digitalization. The No. of Shipping Bills wherein Shipping Bills were not sent for digitalization (from July 2022 to December 2023) are 458521. Custom Brokers wise lists of number of Shipping Bills not sent for digitalization have been enclosed at Annexure A.

Non Payment of DMS charges wherein Shipping Bills have been digitalized/ scanned

5. It has also been observed that DMS charges are not being paid by the Custom Brokers/ exporter wherein Shipping Bills have been digitalized/ scanned. The total No. of shipping bills wherein payments or DMS Charges are not being paid by the Custom Brokers/ exporter are 91490. The Custom Brokers wise lists of Shipping Bills wherein DMS Charges are not paid have been enclosed at Annexure B.

6. In view of the above, all the Custom Brokers/Exporters are hereby informed to submit the shipping bills for digitalization and pay the DMS

Charges, if not paid, at the earliest. In case of default, appropriate action will be taken as per Public Notice No. 23/2022 dated 27.06.2022.
