Sub: Renewal of appointment of M/s. Air India Ltd. as Custodian / Carrier (Customs Cargo Service Provider) for the purpose of transshipment of Import/Export cargo from/to ACC, Mumbai to/from destination Custom Stations within India; – reg.

M/s. Air India Ltd., having its registered office at Block -4, Vatika One on One, Gurugram, Haryana 122007 had been approved as Custodian / Carrier (Customs Cargo Service Provider) for the purpose of transshipment of import/export cargo from/to Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai to/from Airports of Bangalore, Cochin, Chennai, Mangalore, Thiruvanthapuram, Hyderabad, Coimbatore, Indore, Varanasi, Nagpur, Pune, Lucknow, Jaipur, Vishakhapatnam, Calicut, Ahmedabad and Goa (GOX/GOI) , Delhi, Kolkata, Amritsar till 31/03/2026 vide PN no. 16/2024 dated 19.03.2024.

2. M/s. Air India Ltd. has executed Transshipment Bonds in favour of "The President of India" through Commissioner of Customs, ACC, Mumbai in terms of CBIC Circular No. 56/2000-Cus dated 05/07/2000 read with Circular No. 06/2007-Cus dated 22/01/2007 for the proper accountal of goods.

The amount will be debited from the bond when the transshipment cargo is taken by the Custodian and it will be re-credited when the proof of handing over the cargo to the Customs at final destination. The carrier shall produce the acknowledgement with respect to import cargo within 10 days from the dispatch and in case of Export Transshipment, the carrier shall produce the acknowledgement of gateway airport within 30 days of transshipment. M/s. Air India Ltd. will be responsible for shortage or pilferage of the cargo, if any, and if so, they will be required to pay the amount equal to customs duty, cess, and other levies alongwith applicable interest and penalty.

4. M/s. Air India Ltd. has requested for renewal of the permission for the purpose of transshipment of import/export cargo from/to Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai to/from Airports of Bangalore, Cochin, Chennai, Mangalore, Thiruvanthapuram, Hyderabad, Coimbatore,

Indore, Varanasi, Nagpur, Pune, Lucknow, Jaipur, Vishakhapatnam, Calicut, Ahmedabad and Goa (GOX/GOI), Delhi, Kolkata, Amritsar valid till 31/03/2026 granted vide PN no. 16/2024 dated 19.03.2024.

5. Now, in pursuance of power vested in me under Section 45(1) and 54(3) of the Customs Act, 1962 read with circular 06/2007-Cus dated 22/01/2007; I, Hardeep Batra, Commissioner of Customs (General), Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai Zone III, hereby extend the permission granted to M/s. Air India Ltd., as transshipment custodian for the import/export cargo from/to Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai to/from Gateway Airports of Bangalore, Cochin, Chennai, Mangalore, Thiruvananthapuram, Hyderabad, Coimbatore, Indore, Varanasi, Nagpur, Pune, Lucknow, Jaipur, Vishakhapatnam, Calicut, Ahmedabad and Goa (GOX/GOI), Delhi, Kolkata, and Amritsar with extending the period till 31/03/2027.

6. The validity of permission vide this Public Notice is extended as stipulated under Goods Imported (Conditions of Transshipment) Regulations, 1995 read with CBEC Circular No. 69/1999-Cus dated 06/10/1999, as amended from time to time, subject to the adherence of the conditions stipulated below:

a. That M/s. Air India Ltd. shall follow the procedure prescribed in:

- i. Chapter VIII of the Customs Act, 1962;
- ii. Goods Imported (Conditions of Transshipment) Regulation, 1995;
- iii. Board Circular No. 69/1999-Cus dated 06/10/1999, as amended by Circulars No. 61/2000-Cus dated 13/07/2000, 79/2001-Cus dated 07/12/2001, 46/2005-Customs dated 24/11/2005 and 06/2007-Cus dated 22/01/2007;
- iv. Public Notice No. 24/2000 dated 08/11/2000 read with Public Notice No. 12/2004 dated 27/03/2004, Public Notice No. 18/2005 dated 28/07/2005 and Public Notice No. 09/2007 dated 02/03/2007.
- v. Any other Rules, Regulations, Notifications, Instructions, Circulars and Public Notices issued from time to time.

b. M/s. Air India Ltd. is required to adhere to the provisions of the Foreign Trade Policy 2023 and all other allied Acts in force and enacted/amended by the Government from time to time.

c. M/s. Air India shall under no circumstances outsource the transshipment activities under this Public Notice without due permission from the 'proper officer'.
