ADDENDUM to P. N. No. 56/2025 dated 24.10.2025

Addendum to Public Notice No 56/2025 dated 24.10.2025 issued vide F. No. GEN/PSO/Misc/283/2022-PSO/SUPDT-O/o COMMR-CUS- GEN-Zone-III-Mumbai.

In exercise of powers conferred under section 154 of the Customs Act, 1962 the following addition is made to the above-mentioned Public Notice: -

"The list of airlines under the heading "Airlines handled by M/s. AIASL" at the end of the 4th paragraph is hereby amended to include "Federal Express Corporation (Fedex)" as the 7th entry."

All other provisions, terms and conditions stipulated in the Public Notice No. 56/2025 dated 24.10.2025 shall remain the same.

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PUBLIC NOTICE NO. 56 / 2025

M/s Shreeji Translogistics Limited (formerly named as M/s Shreeji Transport Services (P) Limited) having their registered office at M-23, 3rd Floor, Menzies Aviation Boba Cargo Terminal, Bangalore International Airport Ltd., Devanahalli, Bangalore-560300 were earlier granted permission till 24.10.2025 vide Public Notice 45/2022 dated 25.10.2022 to operate as a bonded trucker to transshipment of imported cargo carried by total 44 (forty four) airlines handled by Custodian M/s AI Airport Services Limited (AIASL) and M/s Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. (MIAL) from Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai to outlying Air Cargo complexes, Airports, Container Freight Stations and Inland Container Depots by road through Closed Body trucks (CBT) within India. In pursuance to addendum dated 17.08.2023 to Public Notice 45/2022 dated 25.10.2022, permission was accorded to Hercules Aviation, Air Canada Cargo and ITA Airways as airlines for transshipment of cargo handled by the Custodian M/s Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. (MIAL). In pursuance to addendum dated 19.01.2024 to Public Notice 45/2022 dated 25.10.2022, permission was accorded to Indigo Cargo and Silkway West Airlines as airlines for transshipment of cargo handled by the Custodian M/s Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. (MIAL). In pursuance to addendum dated 10.04.2024 to Public Notice 45/2022 dated 25.10.2022, permission was accorded to SF Airlines as airlines for transshipment of cargo handled by the Custodian M/s Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. (MIAL). In pursuance to addendum dated 27.02.2025 to Public Notice 45/2022 dated 25.10.2022, permission was accorded to M/s Challenge Group Airlines as airlines for transshipment of cargo handled by the Custodian M/s Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. (MIAL).

2. M/s Shreeji Translogistics Limited, has executed a Bond of Rs. 100 crores (Rupees Hundred Crores only) towards transshipment of imported cargo valid for the period 25.10.2025 till 14.10.2025. Whereas, M/s Shreeji Translogistics Ltd. has been granted exemption from submission of Bank Guarantee, in terms of Boards Circular No 24/2006 dated 25.08.2006, as they have fulfilled the condition of having annual transshipment volume above 2500MT.

3. Now, M/s Shreeji Translogistics Ltd., has sought permission to operate as bonded trucker for transshipment of imported cargo carried by 51 (Fifty One) airlines handled by the custodian M/s Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. (MIAL) and M/s AI Airport Services Limited (AIASL) from Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai to Outlying Air Cargo Complexes, Airports, Container Freight Stations and Inland Container Depots by road through Closed Body Trucks (CBT) within India.

4. Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 45 (1) of the Customs Act, 1962, I, Nilank Kumar, Commissioner of Customs (General) Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai Zone III, hereby approve and extend the permission toward appointment of M/s Shreeji Translogistics Ltd. As Customs Cargo Service Provider/Custodian for a further period of three years for the limited purpose of transshipment of imported cargo meant for transshipment carried by total 51 (Fifty one) airlines as detailed hereunder, handled by the Custodian M/s s Mumbai International Airport Pvt. Ltd. (MIAL) and M/s AI Airport Services Limited (AIASL) from Air Cargo Complex, Mumbai to Outlying Air Cargo Complexes, Airports, Container Freight Stations and Inland Container Depots by road through Closed Body Trucks (CBT) within India. The Bonded Trucking permission for transshipment of Imported Cargo is permitted only in Closed Body Trucks and only in such cases, where it is desired by the consignee and authorized by the airlines(as mentioned below) and approved by the Customs department.

5. Whereas, such Transshipment of Imported cargo meant for transshipment cargo meant for transshipment by road through Customs Bonded Trucking from ACC, Mumbai to the destination Air Cargo Complexes, Airports, Container Freight Stations and Inland Container Depots shall be allowed only through Closed Body Trucks by M/s Shreeji Translogistics Ltd.

6. Transshipment of Import Bonded Cargo being permitted as per the public Notice shall be governed by:-

- a) The provisions of Chapter VIII of the Customs Act, 1962
- b) Goods imported (Conditions of Transshipment) Regulations, 1995.
- c) Handling of cargo in Customs Areas Regulation, 2009 (as amended).
- d) Boards Circular No. 69/99-Cus dtd. 06.10.1999 as amended by Boards Circular No. 61/2000-Cus dtd 13.07.2000, 79/2001-Cus dtd. 07.12.2001 and 06/2007 dtd. 22.01.2007.
- e) Public Notice No. 23/2000 dtd. 08.11.2000 read with Public Notice No. 12/2004 dtd. 27.03.2004, Public Notice No. 18/2005 dtd. 28.07.2005 & Public Notice No. 09/2007 dtd. 02.03.2007.
- f) Any other Rules, Regulations, Notifications, Instructions, Circulars & Public Notices issued from time to time.

7. The said permission shall be valid till 14.10.2028 i.e. earliest date o

expiry of required bond submitted by M/s Shreeji Translogistics Ltd.
