Subject : Transfer of Parcels Weighing more than 70 kgs. to Air Cargo Complex for clearance

Attention of all public in general and all importers, Customs House Brokers, Courier Companies working at C.S.I Airport/Air Cargo Complex in particular is invited to Regulation 2(2)(b) of Courier Imports and Exports (Clearance) Regulations 1998, which lays down restriction on the weight of individual package that can be cleared in Courier mode. As per this provision individual package weighing upto 70 kgs. only can be cleared through Courier mode. As per Para 4 of CBEC Circular No.85/98-Customs dated 13.11.1998 goods which are not covered under Courier Regulation and if they are brought by the same courier, separate Bill of Entry may be filed in the from prescribed vide Bill of Entry (Forms) Regulations, 1976 the such goods may be assessed/examined and cleared as normal aircargo.

2. The matter has been examined. In view of above legal position it has been decided that henceforth all the parcels weighing more than 70 kgs. and arriving in Courier mode shall be transferred to Air Cargo Complex Sahar Mumbai. Such parcels will be accessed and cleared as normal air cargo at ACC Sahar, Mumbai.

3. Normal procedure as stipulated in Public Notice No.11/2009 dated 20.05.2009, followed for transfer of Courier Parcels from Courier Terminal to Air Cargo Complex shall be followed.

These instructions shall be implemented with effect from 25.11.2013
